

Benefits of Scouting




Many factors contribute to control and management of wheat. Before spraying, there are tools to help determine the best means of control.



Quick, easy and saves money!

- Sample by walking in a “zig zag” or “W” pattern
- Walk 15 steps (or about 30 feet) between stops
- Fields larger than 80 acres should be regarded as two fields
- At each stop, CAREFULLY pull and examine three tillers, one from left, right and front of you
- On the Glance N’ Go sampling sheet, color in a leaf if tiller has one or more greenbugs on it
- After about five stops (or 15 tillers) add up the number of tillers that had greenbugs and follow the directions on the sampling sheet.
